

Procedure

1. Choose a title, then...
 - a. carefully type the address into your web browser, or
 - b. if working from the website, click on the appropriate link.
2. Log-in to BrainPOP.
 - a. ncs2
 - b. school
3. Watch the movie.
4. Take the CLASSIC QUIZ
 - a. You must score **at least 7** out of 10 to be eligible to submit your results.
 - b. If you do not get at least 7 correct out of 10:
 - Watch the movie again.
 - Take the CLASSIC quiz again.
5. Submit your results.
 - a. EMAIL YOUR RESULTS directly to your teacher.

 - **Type the address carefully!** If you get it wrong, your results will be lost forever in cyberspace.
 - b. You may only submit one quiz result per title.

Questions You Might Have

1. How do I access BrainPOP?
 - You will have some time to work on this project in class.
 - You can go to the computer lab or library during study hall with a pre-signed pass.
 - You can go to the computer lab or library after school with a pass.
 - You can stay with Mr. Van Duyne or one of your other teachers after school and use the computers in their rooms.
 - You can use a computer at home.
 - You can use a computer at the public library.
 - You can use any computer or device in the world that connects to the World Wide Web!
2. How will I be graded?
 - You will earn one (1) point for each correct quiz answer.
 - You *must* earn at least **65** points to pass this project.
 - You *may* earn up to **300** points on this project. That's a **LOT** of **extra credit!**
