law passed to strengthen the Sherman Act; clearly stated that businesses could and could not do, made it easier to break up trusts, made it easier for workers to join union and strike

the main goal of the Progressives  
to improve, to change for the better

gave people more power over who the candidates in an election would be

muckraker who wrote  
The Jungle,  
a book about unsafe and  
unsanitary practices in the  
meat industry

a group of writers who  
described  
the problems facing Americans

progressive President who  
worked to cut down the power  
of business, reduce  
tariffs, and reform the  
banking industry

the name given to  
Woodrow Wilson's  
plan for reform

started Hull House, the first  
“settlement house,” to help  
immigrants adjust to life in  
America

said that U.S. Senators  
would be directly elected by the  
people of their state

law that stated the lowest  
amount a business could pay  
an employee

a group that was able  
to influence who was elected  
to government offices and  
what those people did while  
in office

gave the government power to inspect meat to see if it was safe for people to eat

land set aside for the enjoyment of future generations

muckraker who wrote The History of the Standard Oil Company, a book about the evils of trusts

established a federal income tax

group of Americans who  
wanted to make changes to  
make the U.S. a better nation  
for everyone

the wise use of natural  
resources

a group of businesses who  
combine to create a monopoly
