- 1) Choose at least five names from the list below.

- 2) Do some research to find out how the people you chose contributed to the Progressive movement. Take notes on your research.
- 3) Use your notes to write at least one full paragraph about each person you chose. Your goal is to explain to the reader how and why the people in your project were important to this time in our history.
- 4) Find a picture of each person you chose, or some other appropriate graphic relevant to each person's contributions. You may:
 - find your pictures on the Internet and print them or save them to a disk,
 - find your pictures books and have your teacher scan them for you, or
 - create your own pictures/graphics!
- 5) Organize and prepare your project.

 - In a presentation, you should have a separate card for each person
